Dave Schwartz, the director of the Center for Gaming Research at the University of Nevada Las Vegas, is an author, speaker, and frequently-cited expert on the history of gambling and current industry issues. He has written three books, including the top-selling *Roll the Bones: The History of Gambling*.

Before taking his current academic job, Schwartz worked in casino security and casino surveillance, as well as several other jobs in and around the gaming and entertainment industries.

Schwartz regularly writes for *Casino Connection* and the *Las Vegas Business Press* and his own website, DieIsCast.com. He regularly speaks to convention groups on the secrets of the casino and history of gambling, and consults with government agencies, law firms, and gaming companies.
